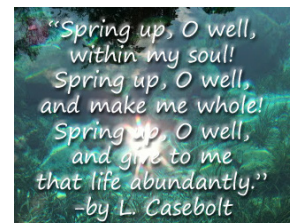
Our next Agapé Meeting - 6 August with [Andrew Cannon](#)
