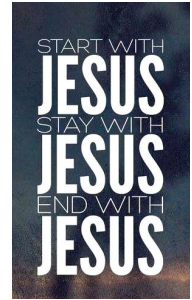


Greetings to all our Agapé friends,

May Jesus, the Giver of Hope, Confidence & Love put a Fresh Heart in you. 2 Thess 2.17

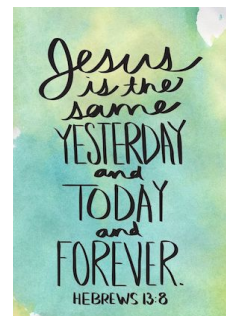
Our next Agapé Meeting - 20 August with Victor Owens
